Turnover and investments based on VAT declarations (absolute figures)

This statistic is intended to produce quarterly short-term indicators. These short-term indicators have to be produced for Eurostat on a quarterly basis. However, for some combinations of Nace code and enterprise location, the quarterly figures are missing because they are confidential. As a statistical institute, Statbel is obliged to protect the confidentiality of the data of individual enterprises as much as possible. Statbel calculates the confidentiality for the whole cube so that its integrity is guaranteed. This means that the amounts of confidential records are included in the subtotals and totals if they are not confidential. Since 2013, confidentiality is only calculated on a quarterly basis and no longer on an annual basis, because after investigation it was found that too many annual figures had to be sacrificed if one quarterly figure was confidential. For this reason, no annual figures have been published since 2013. Users who want annual figures can add up the quarterly figures and estimate any missing quarterly figures.


